

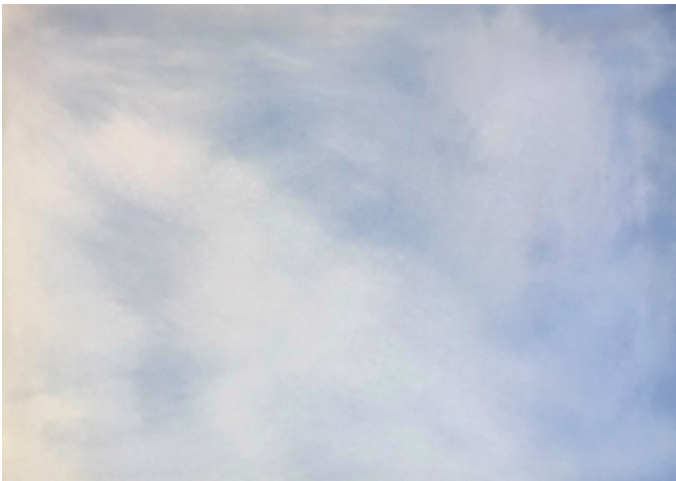

# TIPS AND TRICKS

## How to paint Spring branches

**Colours:** Ultramarine blue, brown, pink, yellow and white

**Background:** Use a large brush dip it in the white and blue go straight onto the canvas, (I mix on the canvas not the palette) doing loose brush strokes to cover the background. More brushstrokes more blended colours, less brush strokes will give you a more streaky background.

**Branches:** Remember branches are always thicker closer to the tree and thinner as they grow out!

**Flowers:** I paint petals with a filbert brush. five short brushstrokes inwards to the centre.

**Flower centre:** With the tip of the round brush or the back end, dabbing white and yellow dots

**White dots:** Spring is in the air... I use the back end of the brush.

Dip in the paint and dot on the canvas.
